Our policy is for zero tolerance. Therefore, if any staff witnesses or confirms, that any of the rules are not being followed, the patron will be asked to leave. If the patron refuses to leave, the Celina Police Department will be called to escort the patron from the building.

The Behavior Policy as posted in the TeenZone:

Be polite and respectful

- Speak kindly and respectfully to others.
- Keep your hands, feet, mouth, and objects to yourself.
- Respect library material, equipment, and furniture.
- Use computers and software appropriately.

Zero Tolerance

When you fail to follow these rules:

1st offense – removal from library for 1 day.

2nd offense – removal from library for 1 week with letter sent to parents.

3rd offense – removal from library for 1 month with letter sent to parents.
